

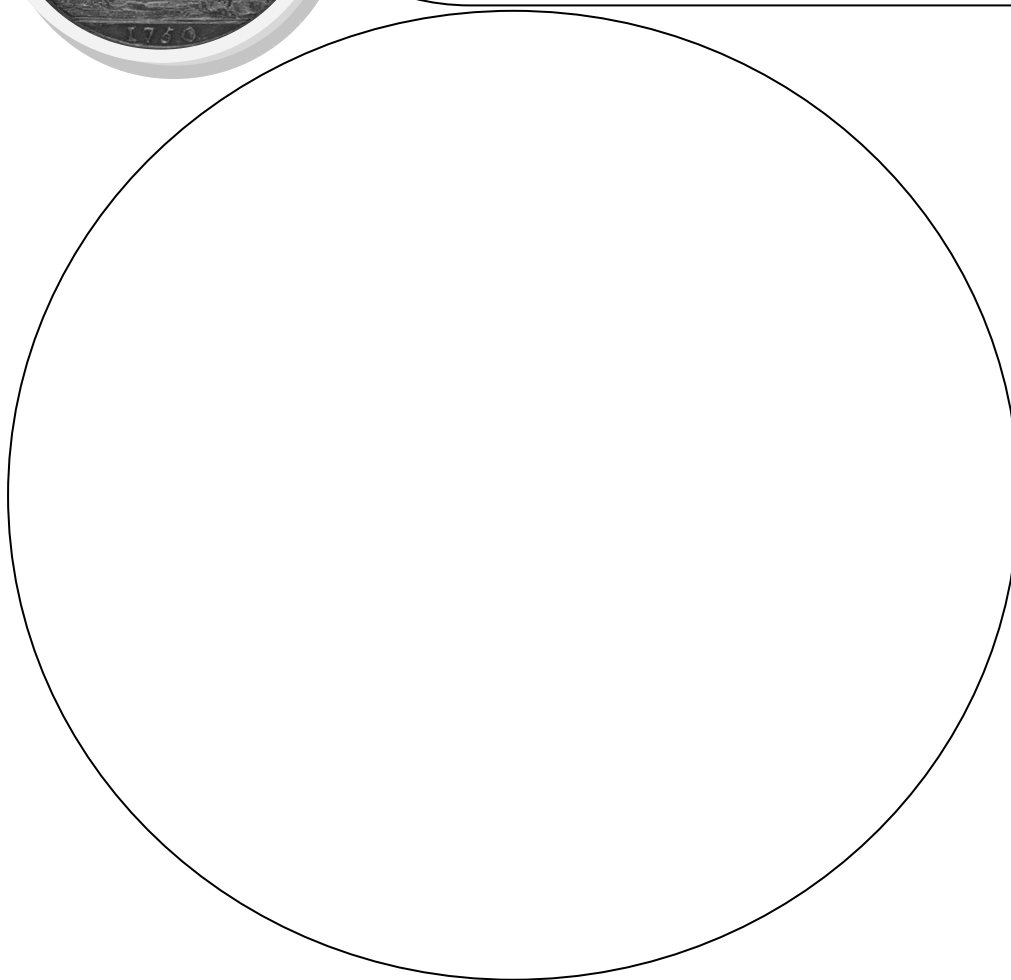
The Battle of Prestonpans 1745
